

THE OPPORTUNITY

Originally from South Africa, the Dekker family emigrated to Texas in 1984. Seven years later, the Dekkers purchased 55 acres with the goal of starting a large tree nursery. Word of the quality and uniformity of their container-grown trees grew quickly among landscape architects, real estate developers and retail customers across the Southwest and Southeast.

By 2023, the Dekkers' farm, now known as Twin Lakes Nursery, had grown to 2,000 acres, with 1,000 acres under tree production. To support health and growth, the trees are sprayed at various intervals, which is labor intensive. Fungicides and pesticides are also expensive. Being a multigenerational, family-owned business, the Dekkers were concerned with the chemical drift and run-off that can result from the continuous spraying of air blast sprayers.

THE SOLUTION

The Dekkers were introduced to the Smart Apply System by a salesperson who explained the benefits of upfitting their air blast sprayer with the precision spray and data system. While saving on chemicals was attractive, saving on labor drove them to purchase a Smart Apply System and begin using it in March 2023. The benefits were immediate: fewer tanks of chemicals were needed, saving labor on mixing and refilling the sprayer. Only one trained operator was needed to spray the entire nursery. With Smart Apply, the Dekkers are able to check which sections of the nursery had been sprayed and which had not. The system's GPS tracking data ensures no tree or row is left unsprayed.

Here's what really hit home for the Dekkers. "We want to be respectful of our impact on the environment and ensure the nursery endures over time for our kids and future generations. We make responsible decisions regarding the inputs we use and the products leaving the farm so that everything is produced environmentally friendly and under great working conditions for our employees. We are constantly trying to use less chemicals and less commercial fertilizers. Smart Apply helps us in this mission," says Deon Dekkers.




Smart Apply uses LiDAR to identify individual tree geometry before applying chemicals.
